Harmonious and juicy while offering the stuffing for the cellar. Ends with salty density and incense smoke, plus a subtle tug of tannins. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2040. 527 cases made, 150 cases imported.

A complex, full style that manages to never feel too heavy. Cassis and sappy plum are held aloft by orange peel acidity and a spine of iron. Nuances of savory spices, smoke and dusty incense move in, with a flash of sweet spices. Cashmere-fine tannins guide the long, winding finish, which is lined in cool riverstone details. Long and complex, with good purity. Drink now through 2040. 250 cases made, 50 cases imported.
